

Usual Procedure

(Normal day)

- A day or two before your appointment, expect a phone call confirming procedure and answering any questions you may have.
- On scheduled day come to the dental office with an empty stomach and if desired, a patch to numb the skin on the hand.
- Pre-op medical assessment.
- Pre-op oral sedation if desired (usual procedure for children).
- Sleep delivered in the dentist's chair while your dentistry is done.
- Wake up with it finished and remain in dentist's office for approximately 45 minutes until fully recovered.
- You are ready to go home with a companion.
